




What is the „Jakobsweg“

Back to business...

Average time: 2 weeks

Average money per day: EUR 55,00

250.000 pilgrims x 14 days x EUR 55,00: **193 Mio.**

BUT:

This is only Spain...

Some reasons for the project

- Walking is nice, but walking with surplus (religious, personality, ...) is better (and better to sell)
- Many private and public organisations, but no European platform
- Pilgrims do not care about administrative frontiers, so information needs to be delivered cross-border
- Pilgrimage in front of the house door gets popular
